PRESIDENTS VISION

The Zimbabwe Olympic Committee President, Mr. Thabani Gonye proposes the following in his election at the helm of the NOC:

- Prioritization of engagement through forums, to come up with a shared vision, for a new strategic plan to run through 2024.
- Keep Athletes at the heart of the Olympic family and Sport movement through increased support for athlete's development at all levels.
- Introduce Sports Science and Technology in our Sport Development pathway to anchor the Long - Term High -Performance Programs/ strategies.
- Focus on resource generation for sustainable growth for the NOC and members by resourcing marketing/ commercial structures for smart partnerships and increased revenue streams from local initiatives.
- Ensure good governance, financial controls, systems development, and compliance by strengthening Capacities and Capabilities (CAP & CAP) of members.
- Introducing a robust performance monitoring, evaluation, and learning framework for all our members.

The Zimbabwe Olympic Committee is proud to announce the following commission appointments by the ZOC President Mr. Thabani Gonye. This is in accordance with ARTICLE 25:1 of the ZOC CONSTITUTION "The President shall, after consultation with the executive board, appoint Commissions and or working groups to undertake special functions for a specified period in line with the strategic focus of ZOC and the IOC". These are Transitional Structures towards the 2021 – 2025 Strategic Plan Development later this year.

- 7. The Medical, Sports Science, Protection of Clean Athletes Commission will in the interim be chaired by the CEO Stephen Mudawarima but there will be Co-option for the substantive Chairperson.
- 8. Media, Communication Public Relations and Diplomacy Commission will be chaired by Ms. Charmaine Chamboko.
- 9. The Gender, Equity and Diversity Commission will be chaired by Ms. Merit Thokozile Munzwembiri.
- 10. Olympic Values Promotion (Olympism), Olympians, Peace, Environment & Safe Sports Commission will be chaired by Olympian Mr. Abel Chimukoko.
- 11. Sport for All and Volunteers Commission will be chaired by Mr. Stonard Mapfumo.
- 12. Human Resources (Human Capital) Commission will in the interim be chaired by the Treasurer Mr. Godfrey Sunguro until Co-option of a substantive Chairperson.
- 13. The Marketing and Resource Mobilization commission will be filled in by Cooption. In the interim the CEO is directly responsible for this commission until Co-option of a substantive Chairperson.

TOKYO 2020 UPDATE

The Tokyo 2020 games, (XXXII Games of the Summer Olympiad Tokyo, Japan) will be held from 23 July-8 August 2021.

Aquatics: We received two slots for swimming under the Universality Rule for 1 male, 1 female – based on the athlete with the most FINA points at FINA-listed events. The final date for application/confirmation of athletes is the 20th of June.

Athletics: Our Marathon runners failed to qualify at the last qualification event in South Africa, the Retail Langa Marathon on the 30th of May 2021. Munyaradzi Jari finished 4th in 02.12.26 whilst Fortunate Chidzivo finished 2nd in 02.35.18 The focus will be on track and field events and the deadline for qualification is the 29th of June 2021,

Golf: Scott Vincent: As at the last publicized Olympic golf rankings Scott Vincent currently lies in position 51 out of the required field of 60 players as at the Olympic rankings published on the 25th of May 2020. With Only three weeks to go before the cut-off date of 21 June Scott stands a very good chance to qualify.

Judo: Qualification events have been canceled and Christi-Rose Pretorius failed to travel also due to the UK Covid restrictions.

Rugby: The Cheetahs will be participating in the Rugby Sevens Repechage tournament in Monaco. The Cheetah's selection panel has selected the final 12-man touring squad and submitted this list to World Rugby. The Union will formally announce the squad in the coming few weeks.

Rowing: Rowing Association of Zimbabwe(RAZ) has selected Peter Purcell-Gilpin as the athlete to compete in the Mlx(Men's Single scull) event at the Tokyo 2020 Games.
